

**NEWTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION**  
**SPECIAL CALLED SESSION**  
**MINUTES OF MEETING**  
**Tuesday, July 6, 2010**

The Newton County Board of Education met in a special called meeting on Monday, July 6, 2010 for the purpose of discussing personnel. Prior to the meeting, new Superintendent Dr. Gary S. Mathews and new Board Member for District #5, Mr. Greg Proffitt, were sworn in by Judge Samuel Ozburn. Mr. Proffitt will complete the term of Dr. C. C. Bates, who relocated out of state.

At 9:45 a.m., Board Chair Ms. Cathy Dobbs called the meeting to order, with the following Board members present: Mr. Johnny Smith; Mr. Almond Turner, Mr. Eddie Johnson and Mr. Greg Proffitt. Superintendent, Dr. Gary S. Mathews and administrative staff members were also present.

Mr. Turner made the motion to adjourn to Executive Session, with a second from Mr. Smith; with all voting in favor.

At 10:30 a.m., the Board returned to Open Session on a motion by Mr. Turner, second by Mr. Smith and all voting in favor.

Dr. Carpenter presented for Board action the Superintendent's personnel recommendations. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the list of recommendations, with a second by Mr. Turner and the motion passing with a 4-1 vote, with Mr. Johnson being the dissenting vote. A copy of the personnel report is attached.

At 10:35 a.m., Mr. Turner made a motion to adjourn the special session, Mr. Proffitt seconded, and all voted in favor.
