

2009-2010 Roger S. Green/Eastside Wrestling Scholarship

The Roger S. Green/Eastside Wrestling Scholarship was created to provide financial assistance and reward to a deserving senior varsity wrestler at Eastside High School. The award is designed to provide assistance with education beyond high school to reward for excellence in wrestling, academics, leadership, teamwork, and service to others.

The scholarship amount will be \$5,000 annually, and the intent is to provide this award for the 2006-07, 2007-08, 2008-09, and 2009-10 school years, so this will be the final year for this scholarship. Plans call for the scholarship to be awarded annually at the end of the wrestling season. The head coach will make the final decision as to who will receive the award based upon the following criteria:

- 1) Be a high school senior at Eastside High
- 2) Be an active participant on the varsity Eastside wrestling program
- 3) Overall "B" or equivalent grade average or higher (preference given to those with the highest levels of academic achievement). Transcript must be submitted with application.
- 4) Will have applied to or have been accepted to a vocational, 2 or 4 year college leading to a skill, trade, or profession and must provide evidence of the same to the coach/Green Financial before monies will be paid.
- 5) Have no school disciplinary record for entire senior year. Must submit evidence of a clear record with application.
- 6) Display evidence of leadership and teamwork capabilities through wrestling participation and/or other indications.
- 7) Have taken the ACT and/or SAT. Submit score with application.
- 8) Community service is not required, but will be considered as a factor in this award.

The intent of the scholarship is for one senior to receive the full \$5,000 amount, however, should the coach prefer, the award may be divided into two separate awards of \$2,500 each in any given year, if two candidates seem to be equally qualified. The monies will not be awarded if there is no applicant that meets the reward criteria, and monies not awarded will not be carried over to future years.

All eligible students must complete the school scholarship application form, attach all info requested above, and submit an essay to the coach outlining the reasons they believe they would be a candidate for this scholarship award. This information should be submitted to the head coach no later than three weeks prior to the annual wrestling banquet or awards ceremony.
