Directions:

4. Complete all the sections of the application, leaving the “Scholarship Name” blank at this time.
5. Make a copy of the application for each scholarship in which the student is applying for at this time.
6. Write in the name of the scholarship at the top of the copied application for each scholarship.
7. Gather all supplemental information required of application such as transcript, recommendations, etc.
8. The student/family will mail the completed packet to the donor. All packets must be postmarked to the donor by the noted due date.

Please note the schools **WILL NOT** send the packet. The student/family is responsible for mailing the packet to the donor.
