**Instructions:**

Students who wish to secure parking decals for their vehicles must complete the following application/registration form, have it signed by parent/guardian, and return to the school resource officers. Available parking spaces will be assigned on an established priority basis upon receipt of the completed application and payment of \$40.00 per space.

Rules and regulations which govern on campus parking and operation of vehicles are appended. When students complete the necessary application form, they indicate responsibility for accepting and abiding by these rules and regulations.

## **STUDENTS PARKING ON CAMPUS**

1. Students parking on the Newton High School Campus must purchase a parking permit and place in the lower left corner in the front window.
2. Cost of the parking permit is \$40.00 per year.
3. A parking application must be completed for each parking space.
4. Priority is given to seniors and students in the work study program.
5. Parking and traffic violations will include the following:
  - a. Giving false information and/or falsely registering a vehicle
  - b. Speeding on campus: speed limit is 10 mph
  - c. Driving recklessly so as to endanger life or property
  - d. Parking an automobile on campus without a decal or shared decal
  - e. Parking anywhere other than your assigned parking spot
  - f. Selling your space to another person
  - g. Parking in areas that are not prohibited.
  - h. Using an illegal decal
  - i. Violation of county, state, federal and school laws
  - j. Parking on campus without permission
6. Parking violations may be handled in the following ways at the administrator's discretion:
  - a. Suspension of parking privileges on campus
  - b. Three days in-school suspension and parent contact
  - c. Three days in-school suspension and student loses parking privilege for one year.
  - d. Car will be towed.
  - e. All parking violations will be written on a discipline referral form and treated accordingly.
7. Students who sell or buy parking spaces from other students will relinquish the right to **EVER** obtain a parking space on campus.
8. A student cannot supply, possess, handle, use, threaten to use, or transmit any weapon or any tool or any instrument capable of inflicting bodily injury as a weapon on his person or vehicle. He/She cannot transport alcohol and/or drugs or illegal substance in his/her vehicle or on his person
9. It is noted that school officials may search a student's car if they have reasonable cause to believe that a student is in possession of contraband.
10. Students that possess parking permits are expected to maintain a good attendance record. Excessive absences (more than three unexcused in one semester) or check-ins/check-outs could result in a student having his/her parking privilege revoked for the remainder of the school year.
11. A student who leaves school without checking out will lose his/her parking privilege to park on campus.
12. I have read the Newton High School Student Handbook and I am aware of the further rules and regulations not outlined in this registration form.  
\* A written excuse from a parent/guardian is due the **first day** you return after an absence.  
\*\***THE PARKING PERMIT IS TO BE ATTACHED TO THE VEHICLE ON THE LOWER LEFT (DRIVER'S SIDE) CORNER OF THE FRONT WINDSHIELD.**

2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENSE: Forfeit early release and dismissal from work study program by scheduling out of program for subsequent semester.

## 80. MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT

OFFENSE: **Theft or attempted theft of a motor vehicle (car, truck, motorcycle, RV, dune buggy, ATV, or anything that is self-propelled.)**

Disposition: Penalty at the discretion of the administrator which may include suspension or suspension to a formal hearing. The principal or designee shall notify law enforcement officials.

## 81. PARKING AND TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS ON CAMPUS (AHS, EHS, NHS, and SLC only)

OFFENSE: **Violating parking and/or traffic rules**

Students have the privilege of driving personal cars to school. Each car must be registered and a parking permit purchased at a cost of \$40 per year. Students applying for and receiving a permit fully understand their responsibility by adhering to the following rules:

1. All automobiles on the school grounds must be registered with the school and must display the current parking permit/hang tag.
2. Tags are non-transferable
3. Lost tags require the purchase of a new tag at **full price**.
4. Parking is strictly limited to the student parking area. **FACULTY PARKING** is marked accordingly.
5. All students **must be licensed** and covered by insurance. The school is not responsible for the automobile or its contents.
6. There is to be no loitering in the parking lot before, during, or after school. No student may go to his/her vehicle without permission from the office.
7. There will be no speeding over five miles per hour, or any form of reckless driving on school grounds such as jumping the curb or scratching off.
8. Students are not allowed to leave the parking lot after entering without an official pass.
9. Inspection of student vehicles may be conducted without notice and without student consent.
10. The parking permit will be revoked for any student failing more than one subject.

In order to park on campus at the beginning of the school year the parking permit should be purchased by the end of the second week of school. All vehicles parking on school property **MUST** display a permit.
