2:00-2:20	<b>Class Meeting with Teacher (synchronous)</b>

**Synchronous**- live virtual learning with teacher and other classmates during “real time.” This includes live-streaming lectures, video conferencing, teleconferencing, and live chatting.

**Asynchronous**- when learners participate in learning absent from the teacher. It includes but is not limited to the following methods: self-guided lesson modules, exchanges across discussion boards or social media platforms, streaming video content, reviewing virtual libraries and posted lecture notes.
